



N.S. as follows: The land I own must be sold and the proceeds therefore given for the benefit of the Catholic Church Saint Lawrence, Port Mulgrave, Nova Scotia, The house and barn to be sold with the land. The movable property I own will be sold and the proceeds given to the parish priest of Port Mulgrave who will have Masses offered for me.

I appoint William MacDonald my brother as executor of my Will.
